

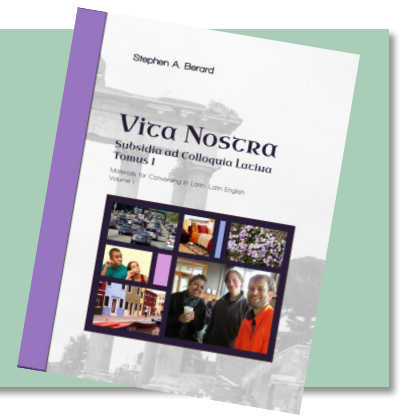

Vita Nostra is a graded manual for developing Latin conversational skills and can be used in concert with any introductory Latin grammar text. Thematized chapters contain a dialog based on modern daily life, questions on the dialog, conversation-starting activities, encyclopedic lists of vocabulary relevant to the chapter's theme, and a special section on idioms and proverbs.

Although *Vita Nostra* was originally developed for use in college courses and spoken-Latin seminars for the general public, many middle- and high-school teachers currently use *Vita Nostra* as a valuable resource. Already experienced Latinists can jump-start their speaking skills with *Vita Nostra*.

Stephen A. Berard graduated from the University of California (Los Angeles) with a BA in Classics and received an MA in Latin and a C.Phil. in Classics from the University of California (Berkeley). At the Monterey Institute of International Studies, he completed an MA in German Studies ("Südländische Musik im dichterischen Werk E.T.A. Hoffmanns") and received a Ph.D. in Germanic Linguistics from the University of Massachusetts (Amherst) ("Infinitive Usage in Biblical Gothic"). In 2017, Professor Berard retired from Wenatchee Valley College in Wenatchee, Washington, where he taught German, Greek, Latin (as a spoken language), and Spanish. He has directed and participated in a host of spoken Latin seminars and currently organizes the spoken Latin activities of the *Circulus Seattlensis* in the Pacific Northwest. Since 2000, Berard has published a variety of works in Latin: *Vita Nostra*, articles on physics, a monograph on linguistics, a book on quantum mechanics, and *Capti: Fabula Menippeo-Hoffmanniana Americana*, the first novel in a heptology of poetic novels (*Heptologia Sphingis*) based on quantum physics and Eastern Mysticism. The second novel, *Praecursus: Fabula Neophysiologica*, is scheduled to be published in 2018.
